



Amendment to Official School Uniform

During the last two semesters we have been diligent in developing a positive identify for our students. We have tried to distinguish ourselves from the chaos so many schools experience with school clothing. I feel very good about where we are presently. The majority of our students are consistently in dress code. This is greatly due to parent supervision and support. The only issue which has troubled us is the overall expense of the uniform bottoms.

I have discovered that the students who were challenging the dress code prior to the uniforms are still doing the same thing with the new ones. If they were wearing tight clothing (girls) or sloppy clothing (boys) they are doing the same thing with the sunshine uniform bottoms.

Because the majority of parents follow the set policy we are going to relax the school policy to include uniform bottoms purchased from other stores other than Sunshine uniforms as long as they fit the following criteria.

- 1) They must be stone or Kaki for Middle School and High School
- 2) They must be navy for Elementary and Preschool
- 3) They must not be too loose (no sagging).
- 4) They must not be too tight.
- 5) They may not be cargo pants (pants with more than two front or two back pockets).

Should student's bottoms fail to meet these expectations they may be required to wear only Sunshine uniform pants. It is important that we continue to maintain the sharp appearance our students presently wear.

Presently we have an outstanding student body. The climate of our school is extremely positive. We want to make sure we maintain the atmosphere. Students who dress sharply behave and perform more appropriately.
