PAYMENT METHODS:

Monthly: 10 payments on the 1st of each month beginning August 1st. Tuition payments are due on the first of each month and are past due after the 10th.

Annually: Payment in full by May 27, 2011

- A five percent (5%) discount is available to any family who pays the annual amount by February 29th.
- A three percent (3%) discount is available to any family who pays the annual amount by March 31st.
- A two percent (2%) discount is available to any family who pays the annual amount by May 25th.

To be eligible for any of the above discounts, enrollment fees and student fees must be paid in full by the date stated.

MULTI CHILD DISCOUNT:

2nd Student – 10% 3rd Student – 15% 4th Student – 20% 5th Student or more – Contact the office

FINANCIAL POLICIES:

A late fee of \$25 will be applied to unpaid balances on the 11th of each month. These fees can't be waived.

All NSF checks will be charged a \$35 service fee per item.

For any account 60 days past due, the students will be suspended from school until the balance is paid in full.

Students with delinquent accounts may not be permitted to attend extended care or participate in extracurricular activities or events.

If you withdraw your student, you are financially responsible for the balance owed through the remainder of the month.

NOTES:

Prospective Kindergarten students must be 5 years old by September 1st.

We do not do testing for prospective students entering K3, K4 (VPK), or Kindergarten. *Preschool*

Preschool children must be 3 or 4 years old by September 30 and toilet trained.

Please note that all rates and policies are subject to change at any time.

ADMISSIONS PROCESS

Step 1: Campus Tour

We invite all prospective students to visit our campus for a personal tour. We also offer a time for students in 3rd grade and above to come and shadow for a day to experience BCS first hand. You may call the school office to schedule at 321.727.2038.

Step 2: Application

- Brevard Christian School utilizes an online admissions application. To begin online application process, visit our website www.brevardchristianschool.com and click on the admissions tab and then on online application. Select Create an Account, then log into your account and Create a New Student Application for each child you wish to enroll. You will then have the flexibility of logging in and out of your account to access your applications. We do have a paper application process if you do not have access to the internet.

Step 3: Organization of All Necessary Paperwork

- A copy of the student's birth certificate.
- A copy of the student's recent report card (Grades 1-12) and transcripts (Grades 9-12).
- A copy of any standardized testing. (Grades 1-12, if applicable).
- Non-refundable \$50.00 application fee.*
- Completed Student Application (Grades 6-12)*
- Completed Records Request form – (Grades 1-12 we submit to previous school upon acceptance).*

Step 4: Admissions Testing

- The Administrative Assistant will call to schedule testing for all 1st through 12th grade students. Results of the test and other academic criteria will be evaluated to determine the student's eligibility for acceptance. This information will also be used for class placement. Achievement scores from previous schools may be accepted for consideration, if taken within one year of application date.*
- Testing Fee \$50.00 due on or before testing date.*

Step 4: Interview

- Grades K – 5: You will be contacted to schedule your interview with Mrs. Stephanie Shekell, Assistant Administrator. For elementary students, the interview is with parents and students.*
- Grades 6 – 12: You will be contacted to schedule a family interview with Dr. C. Grant Endicott, Administrator. For Junior/Senior High students, the interview is with parents and students. The purpose of the interview is to discuss expectations regarding conduct, academics and spiritual life at Brevard Christian Schools.*

Step 5: Acceptance

You will receive a letter of acceptance from the Admissions Office.
